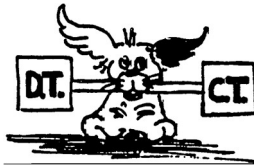

## **ONLINE ENTRIES**

Then look for the trial on your My Local Events page or search by state for (state). Click on the "i" information icon to the right of the club's name to create your entry. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 50 runs online, 300 runs paper each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

**Entry Fees:** \$24.00 for first entry \$14.00 for any additional runs of the same dog on the same day (includes \$3.50 per run for AKC recording fees).

**MAKE ALL CHECKS & MONEY ORDERS payable to "DTCT".**

All fees are to be payable in U.S. Funds.

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

**JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Clubs have no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**DOGS PRESENT** will not be permitted to roam. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

**TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.**

**Obstacles** will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

**This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.**

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.**

**\*\* NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS \*\***

**CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES BEFORE CLOSING:** Entries cancelled before closing will not be charged any processing fees. Entry checks will be shredded.

**REFUNDS:** If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. If a waitlist exists, and your entry could be replaced, then a full refund would be given for the runs that can be replaced, no fees taken. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by judge, barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, or is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly or if a trial cannot open or be completed. No refunds under \$10 will be processed.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** are not eligible to participate. Refunds will be given minus an \$8/day fee upon submission of veterinary certificate.

**Move-Ups**

Move-ups to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, must be received at the trial secretary's address no later than 6PM on Monday, November 4, 2024. Any move-ups from over the weekend must be received by the Trial Secretary Trial on Saturday. No moving down or changing or height after closing except as specified in Chapter 1 Section 21 of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS:**

Exhibitors are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. In the Regular classes, dogs may be entered at the jump height for which their measurement qualifies them or a higher jump height, if the exhibitor chooses. In the Preferred classes, however, dogs must run in the jump height for which their actual measurement qualifies them.

**Site and Trial Information**

**FOOD:** There will be no food available. There are numerous fast food restaurants within a few minutes of the site as well as many casual dining options.

**WATER and SODA:** Please plan on bringing your own drinks and dog water.

Crating will be allowed indoors on mats. **Because of the heat it is recommended that dogs NOT be left in cars.**

Please do not park in front of the Gymnastics facility.

The "Potty" area is in the rear of the building. Do not allow your dogs to potty in the grass in the front of the building or near any of the other businesses.

No crates will be allowed in the ring area (Unit A).

Dogs may not be left unattended in the building.

A warm up jump will be provided on the same turf surface as the ring.

### **Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)**

**As of July 1, 2024**, For Exhibition Only (FEO) may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. **FEO is available for all classes. FEO is 45 seconds for all classes (including T2B), except FAST – where the times will remain the same.**

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
  - Toys must be non-audible
  - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
  - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

***(Note: This section only needs to be published in the Premium List if the Club is offering FEO.)***

### **Fix and Go On (FNG)**

**As of January 1, 2020**, FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

### **Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020**

#### **Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day**

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

**A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.**

**When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1<sup>st</sup> run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.**

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
