Note: Highest means Highest Scoring. Dog means either sex. No trophies will be shipped. All trophies not awarded or claimed before 5 PM on Sunday become property of the Dog Training Club of Tampa, Inc. Persons claiming prizes may be required to show an armband for identification.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**CLOSING DATE for entries is 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 8, 2026** after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or cancelled except as allowed per move up clause below. Entries must be signed by owner or agent and submitted with fees. No telephone or fax entries can be accepted. **EXPRESS DELIVERY services must include SIGNATURE WAIVER permitting them to be left WITHOUT recipient’s signature.**

PLEASE NO photographs or screenshots of the entry form. Paypal payment will be paid to [DTCTampa@yahoo.com](mailto:DTCTampa@yahoo.com). Payment must be made prior to emailing the entry, so proof of payment can also be sent at the same time as the entry.

Included in the entry fees: A \$4.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog will be collected by the American Kennel Club for all Regular AKC classes (fees do not apply to Non-Regular Classes). A Recording Fee of \$0.50 will also be collected for each entry of a dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Obedience. At every licensed or mem-

ber club obedience trial, a recording fee of \$ 4.50 shall be required for the first entry of each dog & a recording fee of \$ 4.00 shall be required for each additional entry of the same dog. These fees are collected by the show giving club and are paid to the American Kennel Club. (New AKC Rule Effective January 1, 2026)

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, unsafe weather conditions or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

### **Transfers (formerly Move-ups)**

- After a dog earns a title, a transfer (i.e., from an obedience class to an obedience class or a rally class to a rally class) may be requested if, according to the owner's records, the handler and dog are eligible and the dog has completed the requirements for the title after the closing date of the trial in which the advanced entry is to be made.
- The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- Transfers may be approved provided the class and judge are available, and the class has not reached its limit.

For a written request regarding a transfer for an ineligible dog and handler team from the "A" class to the "B" class at the same level, please refer to the AKC Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16b

### **ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS**

\* Misconduct at hotels/motels may result in an Event Committee hearing. \* Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their dogs at the DTCT Training Building and at hotels/motels. Your continued responsibility and respect allow hotels / motels to continue to work with DTCT so we can provide you with the best venue possible. Please relieve your dogs in marked areas outside and be careful to not allow your dog to mark or urinate inside or on the buildings, trash cans and cars nearby. Trash cans are placed throughout the grounds-please use them. \* The DTCT Training building is a smoke-free building. \* Per AKC rules no dogs are allowed in the show rings for practice at any time. \* Please bring your own chairs and crates. \* Ex-pens are NOT permitted indoors at our trials because of building size limitations. \* No dogs may be left in the building after 6:00 pm or overnight.

DTCT assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, visitors, children, dogs or property. The welfare of children is the responsibility of the parents or guardian. Parents or Guardians must exercise control and restraint over their children at all times. ## TRIAL SITE INFORMATION

*\*There is no room for RV's pm the trial site. Overnight parking is NOT allowed.*

*\*Charging of EV's using the DTCT building's outlets or those of neighboring buildings is considered theft. The Hillsborough County Sheriff's Office will be notified if anyone is seen doing this.*

*\*Lunch will be available on the premises for a \$5.00 donation.*

*\*Crates and chairs CANNOT be placed directly on the ring matting. Please bring your own mat or use the cardboard pieces piled near the crating area if you wish to use the designated crating area.*

**Stewards of Children** - Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. ### AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.

I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us). I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. 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### INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
